- 2. How is Bisnaga born, and what role does Pampa play in its creation? What does her involvement in the city indicate about her character's capabilities?
- 3. What are Hukka's and Bukka's roles in Bisnaga? How do these roles evolve over time?
- 4. How does Hukka change over the course of his reign? What role does Vidyasagar play in Hukka's evolution?
- 5. How does life in Bisnaga change following Hukka's death? What role does Pampa play in these evolutions?
- 6. Why do Pampa, her daughters, and their two companions go to the Forest of Women? What do they learn about Bisnaga while here?
- 7. Consider the group's life in the forest. How does their dynamic change over time?
- 8. Why does Pampa ultimately leave all of her daughters? Why is she insistent upon returning to Bisnaga?
- 9. What is the significance of Zerelda Li's appearance in Pampa's life? How does Bisnaga respond when they arrive in the kingdom together?
- 10. What does Krishna create in the women's wing? What is the significance of this realm and how does it impact the characters?
- 11. Why is Pampa surprised by Zerelda's feelings for Krishna? How does her regard for their entanglement evolve over the course of the excerpt?
- 12. Why does Pampa want to be seen and recognized? How does she prove her true nature?
- 13. How does Krishna respond to the work Pampa and Timmarasu have done in his absence? Why does he later have them blinded?
- 14. What inspires Pampa to begin writing her account? How and why does Tirumalamba become involved in this endeavor?
- 15. How does Bisnaga ultimately fall? How does Pampa reflect on Bisnaga's fall in her writings?
